Proposed External Materials relating to condition 1A (i)**

Further to our telephone conversation this morning and my subsequent telephone conversation with Ellen Barnes, requesting to change the colour of the external face of the Roof light from a **Syntha Pulvin Plus (Gypsum)XDKB018** to a **Syntha Pulvin Plus M4K0018, RAL 8070**. The reason for the change is that we originally quoted the wrong colour reference for the rooflight, when the colour should of been the same as the approved Screen Plant louvre colour.

Ellen Barnes verbally mention that she could not foresee any problems with the colour change, and suggested I send you both a set of the revised drawings and this letter to confirm our proposals.
