1 The proposed bicycle store, by reason of design of cycle storage/parking, would be contrary to policy T3 (Pedestrians and Cycling) of the London Borough of Camden

2 The proposed bicycle storage facilities, by reason of the low number proposed, would be a detrimental provision to future occupants of the flats contrary to policy T3 (Pedestrians and Cycling) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006 and Camden Planning Guidance 2006.

Informative(s):

1 The applicant is advised that the area put aside is not enough for the 51 bicycle parking spaces required by condition, and the parking system proposed is not secure and may discourage use. In order to ensure the space is effectively used by occupants you are advised to replace the cycle store that has a 'hook and hang' storage system with alternative means of securing individual bicycles for example the 'Sheffield' stand proposed elsewhere on the site.
