Proposal: Installation of diesel engine generator set in an acoustic enclosure to provide standby power to computer centre in Stewart House and located in existing service yard adjacent to refuse compactor and goods loading bay, including replacement of wall with metal framed acoustic barrier with louvred vents and gates (SCHEME 1).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

### Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed generator, by reason of the intrusive size, materials, design and location of the silencer and exhaust flue, would be detrimental to the character and appearance of this part of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area and to the setting of



nearby listed buildings contrary to policies B1 (design), B3 (alterations), B6 (listed buildings), and B7 (conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006, and associated advice in Camden Planning Guidance 2006.
