The proposed advertisement comprises replacing an end panel in the bus shelter [which is already used for the display of an advertisement] with an internally illuminated vertically scrolling advertisement – there is a face to both the internal and external wall of the shelter. It does not raise any design or safety issues in this location and the method / level of illumination is acceptable. It complies with both policy and design guidelines in terms of scale and siting. The Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Design Advisor has confirmed that it does not raise any community safety issues, and it is not adjacent to a road junction or any street furniture.
