## Listed Building Consent Refused

Erection of new extension at rear and internal alterations.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The rear extension would harm the garden setting of the listed building and terrace by virtue of its excessive extent into the garden. It is therefore contrary to Policy B6 -Listed Buildings of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
