DESIGN & ACCESS STATEMENT

This is an amendment to the existing planning permission Ref 2006/4611/P to add full height glazing between the front first floor balustrade and the eaves. This area will be used as a Sunspace to moderate the temperature between the southerly facing windows and the living areas of the house. It will also be used to grow plants. Further to this, the relocation of the front wall to the proposed guest room and alterations to existing openings around the house, some being enlarged and others in filled (as noted on drawings).

<u>Use</u>

The building will be used as a residence as per existing; therefore no changes are being made to the use.

<u>Amount</u>

The footprint of the house is to remain as per existing (205.4 sqm). It is proposed to omit the extension of the rear patio from the approved planning permission.

The internal area of the first floor will be enlarged by I Isqm by adding a glazed façade to the front of the existing external balcony.

Layout

The proposal takes advantage of the sites south/westerly aspect (facing Kidderpore Avenue), for natural thermal control of the existing building.
