Erection of temporary structure in playground to be used as a classroom during building works to school.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission subject to the following condition(s):

Condition(s) and Reason(s):

The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).



The temporary classroom hereby permitted is for a temporary period only. The structures shall be removed from the site by 31/07/08 or when the refurbished classroom accommodation approved by planning permission and listed building consent dated 04/07/06 (2007/0350/P and 2007/0351/L) is ready for occupation, whichever is the sooner.

Reason: The type of structure is not such as the Council is prepared to approve, other than for a limited period, in view of its appearance. The permanent retention of the structure would be contrary to the requirements of policies S1/S2, B1, B6 and B7 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

1 Reasons for granting permission.

The proposed development is in general accordance with the policy requirements of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006, with particular regard to policies S1, S2, SD6, B1, B6, B7, C1.
