Site Description

No 56 is within a symmetrical terrace of 5 houses, dating to c1845-1859, on the north west side of the remnants of Oakley Square. They are of 4 storeys and basements, in yellow stock brick with stucco cornice and quoins, 2nd floor continuous sill band and dressings, and channelled stucco ground floors. They are listed at grade II and are within the Camden Town Conservation Area.

Assessment

A satellite dish was erected without permission on the chimney stack at the front of the building, at a height which could be seen from the street below. This was reported to Enforcement, who negotiated an alternative position for the dish.

The satellite dish has been moved to a position at the rear of the same chimney stack, and lower down, so that it is not now visible from street level. In this position it does not cause any harm to the special interest of the listed building.

Recommend consent.
