Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed new windows on all elevations, by reason of their inappropriate design and materials, would be detrimental to the appearance of the building, the setting of the neighbouring buildings and the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to policies \$1,2,7 (strategic policies), B1 (design



principles), B3 (alterations and extensions) and B7 (conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006, and to design advice in the Camden Planning Guidance 2006 and the Camden Square Conservation Area Statement.

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
