The above property is Grade II listed and therefore all alterations and new works are to match the existing with regards to the method used and to material, colour, texture and profile. Single glazing was installed to the new external doors and windows to allow a 22mm Lambs Tongue Beading Detail to be used, a detail not achievable with double glazed panels. This was discussed and approved with Camden Council prior to the works being carried out.
