

PRIMROSE HILL PRIMARY SCHOOL: ACCESS STATEMENT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Primrose Hill Primary School is a Grade II listed Victorian building with Edwardian additions. Its' design is a typical example of the Robson school building layout where a central assembly hall is surrounded by classrooms on three sides, duplicated on each storey with each floor devoted to either girls, boys or infants. The school is located on Princess Road, a residential street in Primrose Hill, Camden.

The school will undergo substantial refurbishment in the near future. In order to enable the school to continue to deliver the required education with the minimum of disruption it is proposed that a unit providing two temporary class units is installed in the upper playground for the duration of the academic year. Pupils will use the temporary classrooms whilst their classrooms are being refurbished.

2.0 Assessment of provision for DDA requirements:

The temporary classroom unit will be located in the upper playground (refer drawing 10875_00_02) which is directly accessible from the street and school.

The unit will be supplied with a ramped and stepped access. The ramp has the necessary handrails on both sides.

The unit has two toilets. One of which complies with DDA requirements and is accessed from a wide lobby. Both classroom spaces are also fully accessible.
