- 1 Reasons for granting permission:
 The proposed development is in general accordance with the policy requirements of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006, with particular regard to policies S1, S2, SD1, SD6, N8, B1, B3 and B7. - Your proposals may be subject to control under the Building Regulations and/or the London Buildings Acts which cover aspects including fire and emergency escape, access and facilities for people with disabilities and sound insulation between dwellings. - Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. You must carry out any building works that can be heard at the boundary of the site only between 08.00 and 18.00 hours Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 13.00 on Saturday and not at all on Sundays and Public Holidays. You are advised to consult the Council's Environmental Health Service, Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ (Tel. No. 020 7974 2090 or by email env.health@camden.gov.uk or on the website www.camden.gov.uk/pollution) or seek prior approval under Section 61 of the Act if you anticipate any difficulty in carrying out construction other than within the hours stated above.
- You are reminded that the summerhouse hereby approved shall only be naturally ventilated (as confirmed in the letter from Ar'chic dated 31.07.07) and that this permission does not approve the installation of any mechanical equipment. The extractor hob shown on the drawings hereby approved is to allow natural extraction. Should you wish to install any mechanical equipment a further planning application will be required. Such an application would have to comply with the requirements of the Environmental Health Department and Consumer Protection Service (Pollution Team), Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ, (tel: 020 7974 6767).
