Keats House, 10 Keats Grove, London NW3 2RR

I refer to your letter dated 13 September 2006 regarding an incomplete application.

I would like to advise you that after careful consideration of my previous lighting proposals, please find enclosed the information asked for in Condition 2 of the Listed Building consent granted in September 2004 appertaining to the above reference.

i) Condition 2

Five copies each of drawing nos, 153102 AL(0) P01, P02 and P03, 153102 AL(0)55 and 56, and 523102 AL(0) 09 showing highlighted in blue the positions of the new lights on the Library elevations and site plan together with sketches of the new light fitting and mounting frame to be installed at each of the garden gates respectively.

The Windsor Court light was chosen in order to match as much as possible the existing style of the street lights and the pattern of the scrolls and circles in the new wrought iron mounting frames is similar in appearance to the existing frame over the Library gate entrance. I attach photos of the Library gate entrance for your assistance.

Also, I attach five copies of DW Windsor's specification on the Windsor Court light and wall brackets (scroll wall box brackets finished in Ral 9017 black) to be used.

For your assistance, I attach five copies of the photo showing the existing wall mounted light to be replaced on the Library.
