I submit the following information in relation to the Discharge of Conditions:

Condition 2


1. Appendix 1 shows the proposed position of the 9 concrete piles.
2. Appendix 2 shows detail of proposed foundations.
3. Appendix 3 shows the proposed route for the only service trench required for the armoured cable. This will be approximately 30cm deep and dug by hand.

Condition 3

All work carried out will be in compliance with BS5837:2005 (Appendix 5).

1. Tree protective fencing and ground protection will be erected as illustrated in Appendix 4 to protect the small laurel tree in the south west corner of the garden. The trees in the adjoining property will be protected by the existing boundary.
2. No machinery will be used for excavations.
3. No materials will be stored within 10 metres of the southern boundary.
4. There will be no burning of combustible materials on site.
5. The ground around the proposed foundations will be covered with a plastic sheet with plywood boards on top to prevent compaction or contamination of soil.
6. The foundations will be constructed by excavating using hand tools only.
7. All exposed roots (if any) will be handled according to the guidelines as set out in BS5837:2005.
