## **Listed Building Consent Refused**

**Proposal:** Replacement of three timber sash windows with timber casement windows, plus erection of 'Juliet' style balconies to existing dormers at rear roof level.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed installation of the No.3 French windows and No.3 Juliet balconies, by reason of inappropriate scale and detailed design, would be detrimental to the architectural integrity and special architectural and historic interest of the Grade II listed building. As such they are contrary to B6 (Listed Buildings) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
