

If you require advice on whether your building is listed or whether the works you are proposing require Listed Building Consent, you are advised to contact Planning at the address at the end of this application form.</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>The Council may need to notify and gain the direction of English Heritage prior to any decision.</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>Works which need planning permission will require the submission of a separate application. Advertisement consent will probably be necessary if your proposal involves the display of an illuminated sign and may also be necessary for other types of advertisements. All these applications should be made at the same time.</li> </ul>

#### SITE OWNERSHIP

### N.B. You must complete the appropriate Section 11 certificate as part of your application.

- If you are the <u>sole</u> owner of the land to which the application relates complete Certificate A below (<u>Owner means a person having a freehold or leasehold interest with at least 7 years unexpired</u>). This Certificate is not appropriate unless you are the <u>sole</u> owner.
- If you are not the sole owner of the land or if any part of the development goes outside land in your ownership, (even if only foundations) you must complete **Certificate B** below and serve notice on each of the owners, using the wording in Notice 1 below.
- If you do not know the names of all or any of the owners you will need to complete Certificate C or D which will be sent to you on request.
- It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to complete a false or misleading certificate.
