

I refer to your letter dated 10th May 2007 in respect if the above subject, and would confirm the following as requested: -

- 1) A site location plan has been submitted outlining the application site in red. The applicant is not in ownership in any of the adjoining land;
- 2) I would confirm that 9 staff is proposed in total, 3 full-time and 6 part-timers. It is proposed to hold up to 4 classes a day, for 6 days per week;
