**Address: Planning application for proposed change of use at 12 Dorrington Street (Ref: 2007/2125/Invalid)**

I refer to your letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> May 2007 in respect of the above subject, and would confirm the following as requested: -

- 1) A site location plan has been submitted outlining the application site in red. The applicant is not in ownership in any of the adjoining land;
- 2) I would confirm that 9 staff is proposed in total, 3 full-time and 6 part-timers. It is proposed to hold up to 4 classes a day, for 6 days per week;
- 3) I would clarify that the proposal is for change of use of the basement and the design statement has been amended to reflect the above;
- 4) The application form has been amended to reflect the existing use and the proposed use for your clarification;
