- 3 The removed timber fanlights to the office partitions at ground floor level shall be retained and stored on site in dry and secure conditions so that they can potentially be reused elsewhere in the building.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy B6 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
