

## re: Redevelopment of 56-58 Bartholomew Road, London NW5 Planning Reference: 2005/0391/P

Further to recent correspondence, and our telephone conversation on 4 April 2007, please find enclosed a copy of drawing no. S/56BR/01H, which illustrates our proposals for bicycle storage, required to discharge Condition 5.

As discussed, we have located the fourteen bicycles in the lower ground floor store area, which is secure but does require access via the main stairs. We have, therefore, also provided 4 no. Sheffield Stands at ground floor [entrance] level, for visitors' use, which could accommodate up to eight bicycles.

I trust that you will find this arrangement acceptable and look forward to receiving discharge of the condition at your earliest opportunity.

With regard to Condition 3, you confirmed that the wording of the condition was such that details did not need to be submitted to formally discharge the condition. However, as you are aware, the contractor has been liaising with Kevin Fisher, with regard to works to the trees, and obtaining his approval prior to carrying out the necessary works.

Subject to your approval of the above, I believe that all of the conditions will now have been satisfactorily discharged and I would be grateful if you could confirm this to me, in writing. Détails of cycle storage pursuant tous condition 5 of approved solume 2005/0391/P datad 03/05/05.
