The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

### Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed extract cowl located at roof level, by reason of its size, siting and design, would be an incongruous addition to the building, detrimental to the appearance of the building and the area generally, contrary to policies B1 (General Design Principles) and B3 (Alterations and extensions) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.



The proposed extract and input air system by reason of its inappropriate design and location would result in an excessive level of noise and disturbance, detrimental to the amenities of neighbouring residential occupiers and the area generally, contrary to policies SD1A (Quality of Life - Sustainable Communities), SD6 (Amenity for occupiers and neighbours), SD7B (Noise and vibration pollution), SD8 (Disturbance from plant and machinery) and Appendix 1 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
