Alterations in terms of changes to the shape of the lightwells; proposed use of reconstituted stone for lightwells & window cills; proposed louvres located on the north south & east elevations; revised heating system; proposed metal window protection grilles; proposed new chimney repairs to broken stained glass windows with plain coloured glass; proposed new chimney pots, as an amendment to listed building consent dated 13/09/2002 (LEX0000086/R1) for repair and alteration of the property for school and community uses, including subdivision and extension of the crypt area to form classrooms and ancillary facilities, the insertion of windows and a door into the crypt, and the formation of a new pedestrian and a new vehicular access.
