### Site Description

Grade II listed School of Medicine building dating from 1926-8 by P Morley Horder and V Rees. Stripped Classical style, Portland stone over steel frame.

### Relevant History

2006/0809/L – listed building consent granted 27.04.06 for *Internal alterations to offices involving the creation of a new doorway and two new windows in order to provide two smaller office spaces.*

### Relevant policies

UDP 2006

B6 – listed buildings

### Assessment

Consent is sought for a minor alteration within the north west corner of the building, at first floor level.

It is proposed to create a new door opening from the corridor into room K114 (which is currently accessed only from the adjacent rooms, K113 and K115). To do this it is proposed to install a new hardwood door and associated fanlight and architrave to match the existing doors within the corridor.

It is also propose to leave in situ and lock shut the existing original hardwood door which exists between rooms K114 and K115. This is not considered contentious as there is no loss of historic fabric.

It is also proposed to remove the non-original door between K113 and K114 and infill – this is not considered to be contentious as this is not a significant opening and there will be no loss of historic fabric.

Please note that a parallel listed building consent application for the relocation of door D1 (between K114 and K115) in the new opening has been submitted under application no 2007/0420/L.

The installation of a new door in this position which matches the others in the corridor is not considered contentious. Recommend approval with a condition which seeks better scale drawings of the new door in order to ensure that it provides an appropriate match.
