- 1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).



- 2 All new external work to the shopfront shall be carried out in materials that resemble, as closely as possible, in colour and texture those of the existing ground floor elevation of the building, unless otherwise specified in the approved application.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy B1 and B4 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

- 1 Reasons for granting permission.

The proposed development is in general accordance with the policy requirements of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006, with particular regard to policies SD1, SD3, SD6, B1, B3, and B4. For a more detailed understanding of the reasons for the granting of this planning permission, please refer to the officers report.

- 2 Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. - 3 Your proposals may be subject to control under the Building Regulations and/or the London Buildings Acts which cover aspects including fire and emergency escape, access and facilities for people with disabilities and sound insulation between dwellings.
