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

I enclose a copy of a planning application for the development of the above site for the purposes of:

Demolition and redevelopment to provide a building arranged on 3 basement floors, ground and 62 upper floors comprising floorspace for use within Classes B1 (office) and A (retail) of the Use Classes Order; the creation of new public realm and pedestrian routes; the provision of ancillary servicing and other works incidental to the development (149,834sq.m).

The proposal involves a departure from one or more policies of the development plan in force in the area.

The application involves the discontinuance of a City Walkway and stair on the site and the bridge over Bishopsgate to Tower 42.

The application is accompanied by an environmental statement. A copy of the documents accompanying the application will be provided you by Hugh Morgan of DP9. Please let me know if you do not receive this information within 14 days of the date of this letter.
