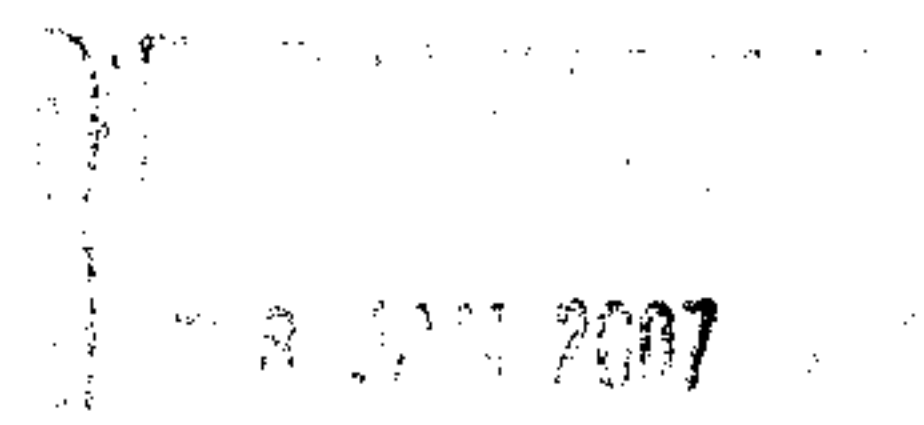

TOWN HALL – BASEMENT SHOWERS

Watts and Partners have been commissioned by the London Borough of Camden Corporate Property Management to provide Green Travel and Ethnic Minority facilities for the Town Hall Complex.

A feasibility study was undertaken and the proposed option indicated in the listed building consent tender drawings was the most suitable to provide the required facilities.

The work involves providing 4 new openings to the basement corridor walls, which will be constructed to match the existing openings within the basement walls. The new openings are required to enable access to the facilities as indicated on Drawing 101750.03.

The London Borough of Camden User Groups (contact Zahra Gilson) have been consulted on the proposed plans and are satisfied with the proposed facilities and layout.
