The form of the screen is to be a new element placed within the historic building touching the historic fabric and not cutting in to it. The glassed screens will be scribed around existing features such as cornices with a soft silicon joint approximately 10mm wide between the screen and the feature, if necessary a separation membrane adjacent to the historic fabric will be incorporated.
