Introduction

1. This Management Plan is submitted in accordance with the agreement dated 2005 between University College School and The Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Camden pursuant to the provisions of Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended by the Planning and Compensation Act 1991) and Section 278 of the Highways Act 1980 in respect of planning application Reference N° 2005/0123. The Plan is fully in accordance with the principles set out in the schedule contained in that agreement.

General Arrangements

- 2. The new University College School swimming pool and sports hall complex ("the complex") has been constructed to contribute to the general improvement of sporting facilities available to its pupils. However, spare capacity will exist, which will be utilised to enhance the wider availability of sports facilities in the School's neighbourhood. Such spare capacity will be managed on a day-to day basis by the School's Enterprise Director and will include the availability of facilities for local groups and voluntary organisations, sports clubs, individuals and other schools.
- 3. Within this context, only those who comply with the eligibility criteria set out in detail at Appendix 1 will be permitted to use the facilities.

Opening Hours

- 4. Overall operating hours for the complex will not exceed 0700 to 2200 on any day.
- 5. Within that envelope, to ensure the maximum benefit to all concerned, the precise hours of available use for and by the various user constituencies will, of necessity, remain flexible. Initially, it is planned that UCS will utilise the majority of facilities availability within normal weekday school hours of 0800-1800. A health and fitness club will operate within the facilities on weekday evenings from 1800 to 2200. There will be periods throughout the operating schedule when external users will be able to use parts of the complex alongside UCS and/or the health and fitness club. At weekends and during UCS holidays, health and fitness club hours will be extended and availability for other external users will also increase.
- 6. Illustrative timetables are included at Appendix 2.

Charges

7. Charges for users who are external to routine UCS curricular activity will be set at appropriate levels reflecting those charged at similar facilities in NW London, including those run by or on behalf of local authorities. Where appropriate and justified by particular circumstances, charges may be reduced or waived altogether. Charges will be confirmed when final construction and commissioning of the new facilities are complete. However, an illustrative scale of proposed charges is included at Appendix 3.

Transport & Car Parking

8. The swimming pool and sports hall complex is located in a predominantly residential area with limited Pay-and-Display on-street parking and with no satisfactory stopping places for buses or coaches. However, the site is close to Underground stations at Hampstead and at Finchley Road and is close to mainline rail stations at West Hampstead and at Finchley Road & Frognal

9. Public Transport:

a. Bus Services:

Many buses stop near Hampstead and Finchley Road and Frognal Stations. Those stopping near Finchley Road include: 13 (from Golders Green to Central London); 82 (from North Finchley); 113 (from Edgware, Mill Hill and Hendon); C11 (from Archway, Parliament Hill and Gospel Oak), and 187 (from Park Royal). Those stopping near Hampstead Station include: 46 (from Queens Park, Maida Vale and Kentish Town); 268 (from Belsize Park); C12 (from Tufnell Park); and 603 (from Muswell Hill)

b. Underground:

Hampstead Station is on the Northern Line. Finchley Road Station is on the Metropolitan and Jubilee Lines.

c. Rail:

Finchley Road & Frognal Station is on the North London Line which connects Richmond, Kew, Acton and Willesden with Camden and Highbury and Islington.

West Hampstead Station is on ThamesLink and connects to stations in outer . North London and Hertfordshire, and to King's Cross/St Pancras.

- 10. **Parking.** The Swimming pool and sports hall complex is situated in a predominantly residential area. Although there is limited pay and display parking nearby, these bays are rarely vacant and opportunities to park near the site are slight. There are a limited number of parking spaces available within the grounds with some spaces designated for use by the disabled. Swimming pool and sports hall complex car parking will not exceed provision for 90 vehicles.
- 11. **Cycling Facilities.** Facilities for the safe storage of bicycles are available on site.

Compliance

12. Records of subscribing individual members and organisations using the Swimming pool and sports hall complex will be maintained such as are sufficient to demonstrate compliance with the principles set out in this management plan.
