Dear Sirs

Re: St. John's Downshire Hill - Railings to south elevation

Please find enclosed 6 copies of a listed building consent application for alterations to the existing railings on the south elevation.

The existing railing was reinstated when the main conservation effort was undertaken in 2003/4 however the church needs a safer proposal with a railings that conforms to current building regulations in height, and also safe for children.

For this reason we have proposed that the whole length of railing is lifted up on a new parapet and a glass screen installed behind where the drop is greater than 600mm. The extent of the glass screen is shown on the drawings; and we have shown how the screen is fixed on a detailed section with 3mm steel clamps which can be removed

We trust you have all the information you require to determine the matter.
