We hereby submit, on behalf of Belsize Lane Limited, our planning application for the above along with the following documentation:

29 Belsize Lane was previously a pub which is currently in the process of being converted into a restaurant.

This proposal involves removal of the existing entrance doors and replacing them with a new single planar glazed pivot door. Previous consents included two sets of entrance doors on the Belsize Lane frontage but now the internal arrangement of the restaurant has changed so that the second entrance door is no longer required.

In keeping with the openness elsewhere in the existing façade and the modern interior of the restaurant it is proposed to install a new simple planar glazed entrance door and over-panel in the existing opening. This would be the only modern element on the otherwise restored façade signaling the modern restaurant behind and improving the visibility into the restaurant. In addition, the single to door leaf would make the entrance easier to negotiate than the existing heavy timber double doors, particularly for those with disablilites.
