Discharge of Condition 4, 5 & 14

We write to discharge conditions 4, 5 & 14 of the above consent.

Condition 4:

Regarding Condition 4 we enclose drawings from Churchman Landscape Architects on the landscaping proposals. Chris Churchman is an enabler with Cabe space and a design advisor with the London Development Agency.

These drawings have been revised from the consented planning application drawings to take account of underground drainage found on site, under some areas where trees were previously shown, but otherwise the scheme design principles as set out in the planning application report still apply. We believe that the landscaping will make a very positive contribution to Frognat and the immediate environment.

Condition 5:

Condition 5 is for the planting to be carried out by the end of the season following completion. Under a separate contract UCS has decided to refurbish the listed piers and railings around the site of the Sports Centre, which will significantly enhance the conservation area. This contract is expected to follow on after the main building contract, which completes in October 2006. It has been decided to defer the soft landscaping until after the piers and railings refurbishment, because otherwise that would all be destroyed by the building works, anticipated to start in Spring 2007. We will update you when more detailed dates are known.

Condition 14

The cycle provision for Condition 14 is shown on the general arrangement plan and is as per the consented scheme drawings, with 6 cycle rack spaces.
