

Option 1 (Plexineon mounted with Clip)

This method is preferable, as this utilises the standard Plexineon mount clip. If ever required the Plexineon can easily be removed, and re-mounted.

An optional Lens cover would be needed to attach a colour filter, if non-standard colour is required.

Option 2 (Plexineon mounted with Silicone)

10 10mm gap at rear of fitting to allow for cables and connectors.

Minimum of 3mm either standlow for adequate silicontents.

This method would require a sharp knife to remove the silicone, before Plexineon can be removed if ever required. Also installation is more complicated than option 1, as the plexineon would need to be supported fully until silicon is set firm.

Minimum of 3mm either side of Plexineon to allow for adequate silicone fixing by contractor.
