- 3 The Council requires that two Silver Birches be planted as standards with a girth size of 12-14cms. The ground should be prepared to the standards set out in BS5236:1975. The tree should be suitably staked and tied. The replacement should be planted as soon as reasonably possible in the planting season following the removal of the trees (November - March)

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
