- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 1989. (Recommendation for Tree Work)
 - Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).
- The Council requires that a Cherry be planted as a standard with a girth size of 12-14cms. The ground should be prepared to the standards set out in



BS5236:1975. The tree should be suitably staked and tied. The replacement should be planted as soon as reasonably possibly during the planting season following the removal of the tree (November - March)

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
