Site Description

Existing metal and glass bus shelter on the pavement outside Ainsworth House, a Council owned block of flats that is well set back from the street. The pavement at this point is relatively narrow [at. approx. 3m wide], so the bus shelter causes a restriction in payement width. The main "elevation" of the shelter is divided into four vertical bays, with a "transom" at approx. halfway height. There are currently two small non-illuminated signs; one in each of the outer bays. The site is not within a conservation area.
