Anyone who cuts down, uproots, tops, lops, wilfully destroys or wilfully damages a tree subject to a preservation order without giving a section 211 notice (or otherwise in contravention of section 211) is guilty of an offence.

If convicted, you could be liable to a fine of up to £20,000. Anyone who carries out work in a way that is not likely to destroy the tree is liable to a fine of up to £2,500

#### Warning

The amended section 194 of the 1990 Act provides that it is an offence to furnish false or misleading information or to withhold material information with intent to deceive. Section 193(7) enables the Council to revoke, at any time, a certificate they may have issued as a result of such false or misleading information.
