I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that he has considered your Council's application submitted with your letter of 8 November 1976 for listed building consent for the alteration of No 52 Mornington Terrace, NW1, which is on the statutory list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest in Camden. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of regulation 10 of the above Regulations.

It is noted that no objections were received following public advertisement of the proposals and that the Greater London Council raise no objection to this scheme, which involves the conversion of the existing property into 2 self-contained maisonettes and a self-contained bedsitter. No reason is seen, therefore, to withhold the consent sought, and, accordingly, the Secretary of State hereby grants listed building consent for the alteration of No 52 Mornington Terrace NW1 in accordance with your Council's application dated 19 August 1976 and the submitted drawings 7610 8 and 7610 10.

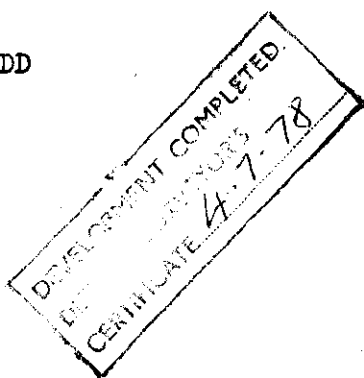
