
Studio







NB Studio building previously remodeled and clad. Doors not original



The studio building is to be connected to the main building via a stair enclosure and the new basement construction.

The present exterior elevation, door area, will become internal to the stair enclosure and as such is required to be a fire resisting enclosure. The proposal is to remove the doors and replace them with a wall and frameless glazing.

The glazing will be opaque, allowing light into the studio, while defining the end wall to the new dining area (basement extension). Refer to drawings no. 425 S'x'01, E'x'03 and P'x'02 for the existing configuration and S'01, S'03 and P'02 for the general arrangement of the proposals;

Bay windows

The bay windows constructed as part of the 1930's extension presently sit over the basement light well.

The attached pictures describe the bay windows. The existing right hand window is constructed as one panel and is fully openable.

The new roof garden to the basement room will sit under the existing bay window.


To allow access to the garden the detailing of the right hand window panel (no 5) is to be copied to the adjoining panel (no. 4)

1930's Garden wall/ gates to the street.

The gates and wall is to be removed to allow the formation of a wall to match the existing, running between the studio and the 1930's extension. The wall will enclose the stair to the basement.

Studio + side wall




Basement light well, outbuilding, stairs and kitchen window.


The basement light well and kitchen extension as well as the outbuilding and stairs were constructed in the 1930's.

The proposal is to construct a new room at basement level with a roof garden at court yard level.






B Kitchen windows (and wall to extension)




C Light well stairs




E Basement extension



F Roof to basement entrance




D Basement extension
