The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The retention of the single storey storage building, by reason of its location within a garden which has already been significantly developed by other permanent structures would be detrimental to the total amount of amenity space available to the occupants of the lower ground floor flat, contrary to Policy B3 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006 and advice given in the



Swiss Cottage Conservation Area Statement.

The retention of the single storey storage building, by reason of its location within a garden which has already been significantly developed by other permanent structures, would be detrimental to the landscape setting and sense of openness of the garden and the character and appearance of the surrounding conservation area, contrary to Policies B1, B3 and B7 of the of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006 and advice given in the Swiss Cottage Conservation Area Statement.

The Council has authorised the Planning Department to instruct the Borough Solicitor to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging breach of planning control.
