## **Full Planning Permission Refused**

#### Proposal:

Erection of glazed porch behind tradesman gate on Gardnor Road, 2 timber pergolas on either side of it, associated increased height of boundary wall on south side of gate, and erection of timber trellis around perimeter of roof of basement extension.

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

### Reason(s) for Refusal

The southern pergola, porch and trellis and increased height of the boundary wall, by reason of their location and height and consequent visibility in the streetscene, would be detrimental to the special architectural and historic interest of the listed building and its setting and to the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to policies EN1 (General environmental protection and improvement),



Director Peter Bishop EN13 (Design of new development), EN21 (Alterations to existing buildings), EN25 (Railings and garden walls), EN31 (Character and appearance of conservation areas) and EN38 (Preservation of listed buildings) of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan 2000.

## Informative(s):

You are advised that no objection is raised to the proposed pergola on the northern side of the gate and no objection to the pergola on the southern side provided that it does not project above the height of the existing wall.
