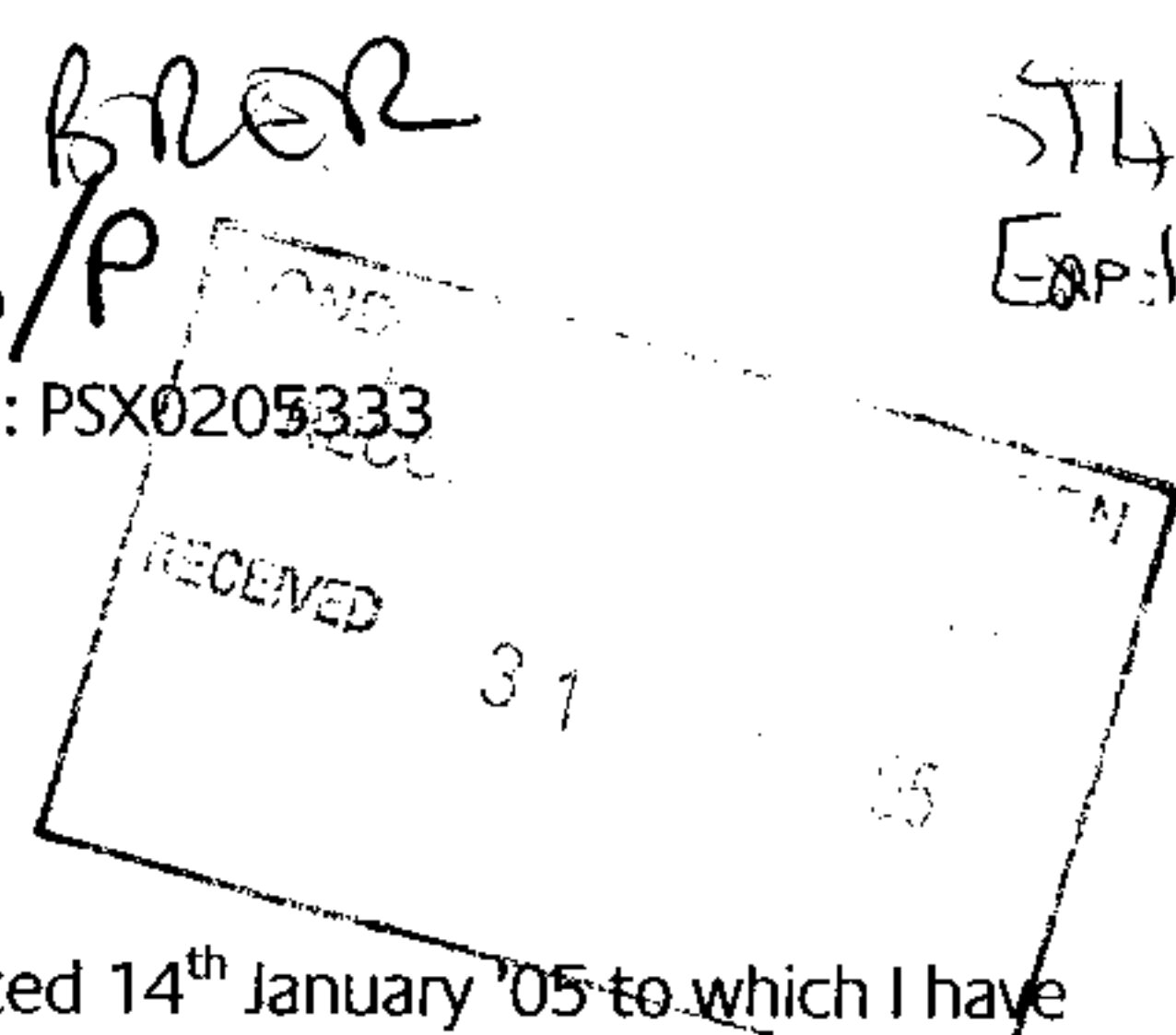

Further to my recent telephone conversation with Amy Ford, we confirm that, due to site conditions, it will not be possible to lay Marshall's Tegula blocks to the road carriageways as shown on the approved drawings. A survey of the existing basement construction to the Lazari Maples Building has shown that a concrete slab is located just below the road surface running from Grafton Way to Beaumont Place. The shallowness of the slab coupled with the levels of the existing exits from Maples will not give sufficient depth to lay 80mm blocks on a 50mm sand bed. This is illustrated on our enclosed drawing 90_ZX 125.

Due to the site conditions we have reluctantly concluded that we have no option other than to lay a wearing coat of asphalt over the basement slabs to form the carriageway finish. We are, therefore, formally seeking your agreement to this change. We have amended our site drawings accordingly and enclose two copies of each of the following for your consideration:
