Fulfilment of condition relating to Archaeology

I have received the evaluation report for the above site prepared by Archaeological Solutions. No significant archaeological remains were found in either of the two trial trenches. Documentary research suggests that rubble layers on the site may have been the result of demolition following bomb damage.

I therefore advise the London Borough of Camden that no further archaeological work is necessary under this application and that the archaeological conditions have been satisfied. The results of the archaeological evaluation will be published in summary form in the London Archaeologist and a copy of the report will be deposited with the local studies library.
