- 1. This is a 'tree-friendly' scheme to improve conditions within the root zone of the existing tree and to keep the impact of work associated with the replacement fence works to a minimum.
- 2. The area of soft landscape under the tree has been extended
- 3. It is proposed to relocate the existing gate further away from the base of the tree
- 4. The steps and path leading to the gate will be constructed from large stone flags laid on the consolidated soil (i.e. no foundation works)
- 5. The proposed replacement fence is a post and panel construction; posts fixed in excavated pits approx 750 x 750 x 600mm deep starting at a depth of approx 600mm below existing ground level on the garden side (i.e. the principal root zone)



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
