No new plumbing, pipes, soilstacks, flues, vents or ductwork shall be fixed on the external faces of the building unless shown otherwise on the drawings hereby approved.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policies EN1 and EN13 EN31 and EN38 of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan 2000.

No new grilles, security alarms, lighting, cameras or other appurtenances shall be fixed on the external faces of the building unless shown on the drawings hereby approved.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policies EN1 and EN13 EN31 and EN38 of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan 2000.

Any hidden historic features which are revealed during the course of the works shall be retained in situ, work suspended in the relevant area of the building, and the Council as local planning authority notified immediately. Provision shall be made for their retention and/or proper recording, as required by the Council.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy EN38 of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan 2000.

The works hereby permitted shall be begun not later than the end of five years from the date of this consent.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.
