PERMISSION FOR DEVELOPMENT - Subject to Conditions

Address: Phoenix Gardens, Stacey Street, WC2.

Date of Application: 03/03/2003

Proposal:

The removal of the existing timber hoarding and the replacement of a concrete dwarf wall with a low brick dwarf wall together with the installation of traditional style railings along the boundary with Flitcroft and Stacey Streets, together with the installation of new gates within the existing modern railings in matching style, as shown by drawing numbers: 283.020 and 021, and 2 unnumbered photographs.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission subject to the following conditions:

Standard condition:

The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Standard Reason:

In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.





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Additional conditions:

The traditional style railings shall be painted black unless an alternative colour/finish is submitted to and agreed in writing by the Council. The gate hereby approved shall be painted to match the existing railings. The gates and railings shall then be retained and maintained in the approved form unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Council.

Reasons for additional conditions:

In order to protect the visually amenity of the area and in accordance with Policy EN31 (Character and appearance of conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan 2000.
