You also requested additional information in relation to conditions 02, 05 (external lighting), 06, 09, 10 and 14. Please find enclosed our response to your queries, we apologise for the delay in replying but we were awaiting final confirmation of mechanical equipment to be installed:

Condition 02 & 09

We have previously issued plant layouts to yourself and Dr Anani and we assume the only outstanding issue is confirmation of the equipment's acoustic ratings at fifth floor plant area.

Please find enclosed a bound copy of our acoustic consultants report and a second copy, the report confirms that the proposed installation will meet the requirements imposed by Dr Anani.

Condition 05

External Lighting to access road – Please find enclosed a copy of the Mezzanine ceiling layout which shows the position of the external down lights to light the pavement areas to the access road. The fittings are both energy efficient and low maintenance. We have also enclosed a copy of the fitting types proposed.

Condition 06

External Works - Please find enclosed a Ground Floor Plan with hard landscaping highlighted. Our aim is to match all external finishes with the adjacent sites existing landscaping in order that continuity is achieved between the two developments.

Condition 09 - See Condition 02

Condition 10

Provision for access for disabled persons – As we previously stated in our letter dated 25.04.01, the scheme is providing two lifts designed for disabled use, access to all floor levels and we are now providing three disabled standard unisex public WC's, one at basement, ground and mezzanine levels.

The scheme is providing seven in total Guestrooms for disabled users on the second, third and fourth floors, all these rooms are interconnecting with an adjacent room to cater for a possible minder.

- 4 Physically Disabled Rooms: Bedrooms to full physically disabled standard, with larger bathroom & disabled shower and 1500mm turning circle in bedroom & bathroom.
- 1 Ambulatory Disabled Room: Bedrooms for ambulatory disabled, with hotel standard bathroom augmented by grab rails. Standard bedroom layout.
- 1 Audio Disabled Room: Standard hotel bedroom & bathroom augmented by alarm lighting.
- 1 Visual Disabled Room: Standard hotel bedroom & bathroom augmented by management system to aid visually disabled with Braille instructions and policy of consistent location of all equipment / accessories.

Condition 14

Provision of bicycle storage – See External Works drawing for position and copy of proposed Stand Type enclosed. Due to the minimal amount of external space to this site there may only be space for 3 to 5 stands.
