**Erection of two external metal directional (deliveries)
signs to terracotta columns at high level,

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reasons for Refusal

1. The signs, by reason of their number, location, being fixed to the terracotta columns at high level, and method of fixing to those columns, harm the special architectural and historic interest of the listed building. In this respect they are contrary to policy EN43.

Informatives (if applicable)

- 1 The positioning of one sign to each property at fascia level is likely to be acceptable.
