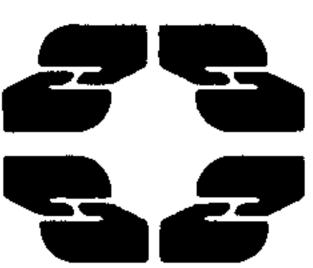

Listed Building Consent

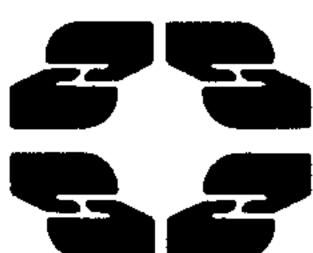

- O3 That detailed drawings or samples of materials, as appropriate, in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority prior to the commencement of the work:—
