REFUSAL OF PERMISSION FOR DEVELOPMENT

Proposal:

Continued use of the site as a skip waste transfer station together with the retention of a building on the site until 31st March 1998 and in non compliance with an enforcement notice (ref ENF 1741) upheld on appeal on 9 July 1997 which requires the use to cease by the 31st December 1997, as shown on one unnumbered site plan.

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse permission for the following reason(s):

Reasons for Refusal

The scale of activity on the site and the method of operations employed is causing a sudstantial loss of amenity to neighbouring occupiers and to the area generally by virtue of the volume of traffic generated, noise, dust and smell nuisances.



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Informatives (if applicable):

You are advised that the Council attaches considerable importance to securing compliance with the Enforcement Notice requiring the cessation of the use of the site as a skip waste transfer station. The Council will therefore commence legal proceedings to secure compliance with the Notice if the use continues on the site after the 31st December 1997.
