The proposal constitutes undesirable backland development which would be detrimental to the amenities of the adjoining and adjacent properties; the proposed building would not comply with the Council's daylighting standards; the density of the main house would be rendered excessive as a result of the subdivision of the site and the access to the bungalow is considered to be unsatisfactory.
